The Writing PROCESS

At UNOI, we believe that the love for reading should be accompanied by the love of expressing what we feel when we read something. However, writing is a complex process and it becomes even more difficult when we are trying to do it in another language. This is why we have developed an amazing writing program for this series, which is directly linked to the Maker Zone activities in your *Shaping My Language* learning log.

Throughout these pages, you will have the opportunity to develop your writing skills using a well-structured writing approach which has six steps: *Analyzing, Brainstorming, Organizing, Drafting, Editing, and Publishing & Assessing*. This will allow you to understand and write different types of texts with the help of straightforward and purposeful activities from start to finish. Each step provides essential insight for the whole process.



In this first stage, your teacher and you work together to read and understand a model text.

Let your imagination flow to come up with new and creative ideas for your text.



Publishing & Assessing

In this stage, write your text again after considering a classmate's feedback. Now that you have read and discussed other texts, you can improve your own text with what you think is important and relevant. Finally, evaluate your work and let a classmate and your teacher do the same.



Editing

05

This stage is divided into two steps: self-editing, and proofreading. First, re-read your own text to mark up any mistakes you find. Then, exchange your text with another classmate to get their feedback. Finally, your teacher proofreads the text and makes any necessary comments.

Drafting

Make your first attempt to write what you want in the target format. Focus more on the meaning and the purpose of your text.
